Classes:	Individual long distance: W16, M16, W18, M18, W20 and M20. Relay: 6 legs in following order: First leg: M18 and W18 Second leg: W16 and M16 Third leg: W20 Fourth leg: M20.
	M18 change to W16, W18 change to M16, the last one to finish on second leg (W16 and M16) hand over to W20.
	Open courses: Easy 2,5 km, Medium 3 km and Advanced 3 km (Saturday and Sunday).
Fee:	Competing runners and team leaders € 60, the fee includes meals and accommodation on hard floor (bring own sleeping bags and mattress). Open courses and model event: € 15 /person (8 € <18 år)
	SI rental € 3 SEK (lost SI € 60).

	Payment for participation in BJC must be made in advanced, open courses paid on the site of competition.
Competition centre:	Västerviks OK´s club house. Address: Vassbäcksvägen 2, 593 32 Västervik. Distances from competition center Mode levent: 1000 m Long distance: 8600 m Relay: 0 m Accomodation:1100 m
Accommodation:	Hard floor in Ludvigsborgsskolan. Bring own sleeping bag and mattress. Address: Lektor Berlins väg, 593 50 Västervik.
Meals:	Breakfast and dinner is served in the food court of Ludvigsborgsskolan in same building as accommodation. Lunches will be served at the competition arena both days.
Transportation:	Teams are responsible for their own transportation during the weekend.
Terrain:	Mostly forest with some forest roads and paths, otherwise areas of close to sea character terrain where both larger and smaller marshes are interspersed between the, sometimes detailed, height sections.

Medium hilly and detailed terrain, close to the sea some areas with sharp elevations will be passed on the long distance. Parts with open terrain with very good visibility, up to 100 m, and only limited areas with reduced visibility or runnability.
